

Video Interview Questions

Bachelor of Design and Bachelor of Visual Arts

- 1. Can you tell us about yourself and your experience / achievements: schooling, work, hobbies, sport, local community, and cultural activities, etc.?
- 2. Who are the artists/designers who have influenced you in some way? What interests you about their work?
- 3. Have you recently visited or seen any exhibitions, festivals or cultural events that have excited you? What was inspiring about those events?
- 4. Tell us about the work that you think is the most interesting or resolved in your folio. Tell us about your ideas and intentions for the work and your process.
- 5. Tell us about the kind of art/design you are interested in making at ANU's School of Art and Design.

Guide to creating interview video

Videos can be recorded using a phone, a laptop or a video camera or any other form of video recording device. Videos do not need to include examples of your work although you may find it useful to have your portfolio handy to refer to. Suggested ways to record your video include: via Zoom with a device that has a video camera; a phone with the camera turned to selfie mode. Your video will be **between 5 and 10 minutes** long. Interviewers will stop watching at the 10-minute mark.
